## **Pentyrch Bowling Club: Booking Arrangements**

The Welsh Bowls Federation has stipulated that all clubs must use a green booking system to ensure safety during COVID-19 and to give all those wishing to play singles an opportunity to do so. A maximum of 6 people is allowed on the green at any one time, playing on alternate rinks.

- 1. The first games can start at 1 pm and they will last for a maximum of 75 minutes. If demand is not high, time slots can be increased to 90 minutes. Games must be played on either rinks 1, 3 and 5 or 2, 4 and 6. There must be a break of 30 minutes between games on the same rink.
- 2. A maximum of 24 people can play on any one day (assuming 75 minute slots). If the slots increase to 90 minutes, then 18 people can play on any one day.
- 3. If you wish to play singles, first arrange it with another member and then contact the *booking officer* to book a specific time, day and rink slot. Different booking officers will be used, possibly on two-week shifts, and their names will be circulated to all members. A booking timetable form will be used by the booking officer, so that a record of all games will be kept.
- 4. Men's, ladies' and mixed bowls can be played on any day and no days will be set-aside for men's only and ladies' only bowls.
- 5. There will be no internal competitions or Spoons this year and money must not be exchanged
- 6. It is vital that the local COVID-19 'rules' are followed carefully and that all mats, jacks, bowls and locks etc are sanitised or disinfected after all games.
- 7. The toilets, pavilion and changing rooms must be kept locked

at all times. The outside tap can be used, but must be disinfected after use.
